Numerous scientific researchers and aquaculture professionals from all over the world will gather to present the latest advances in science and technology.

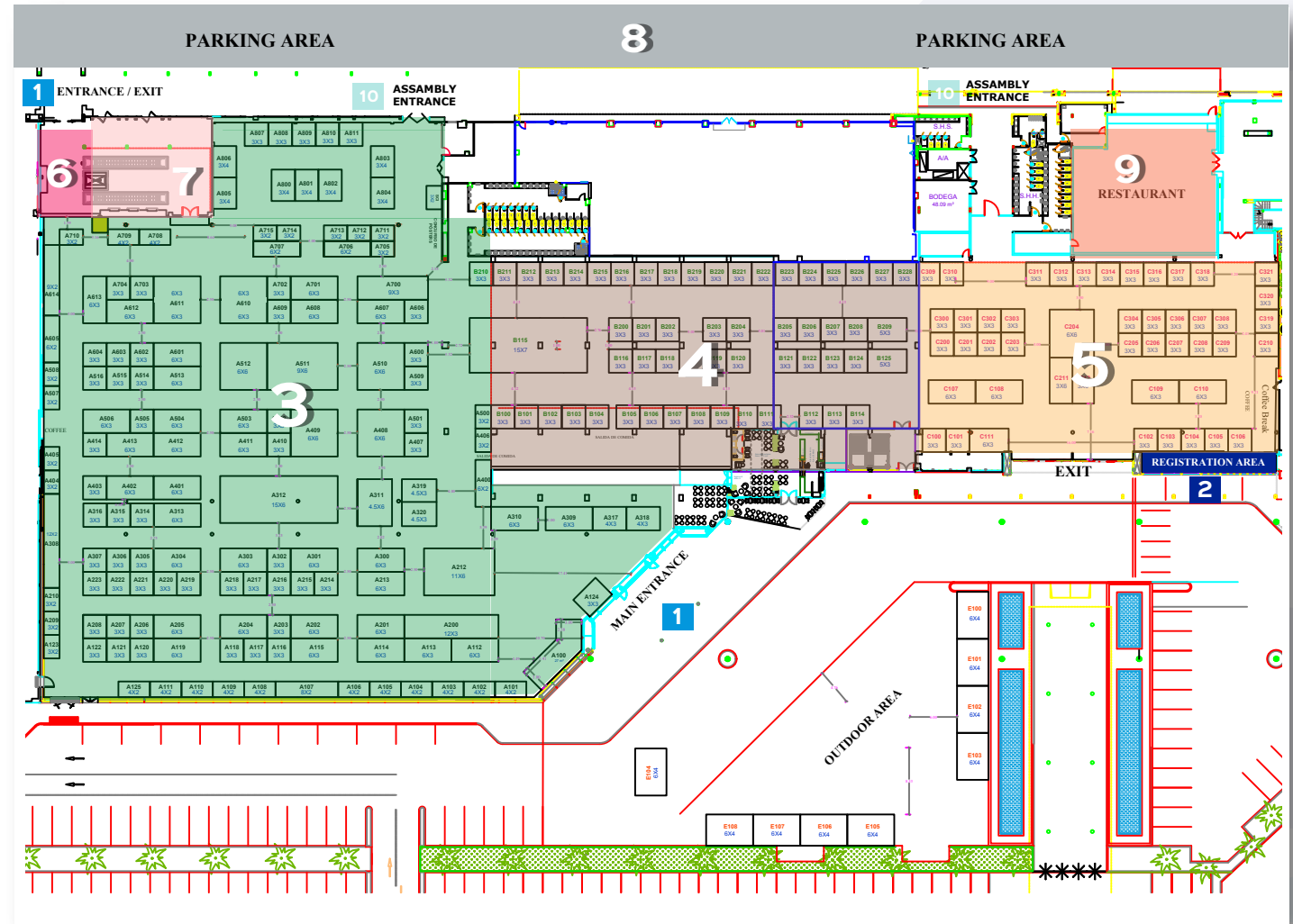

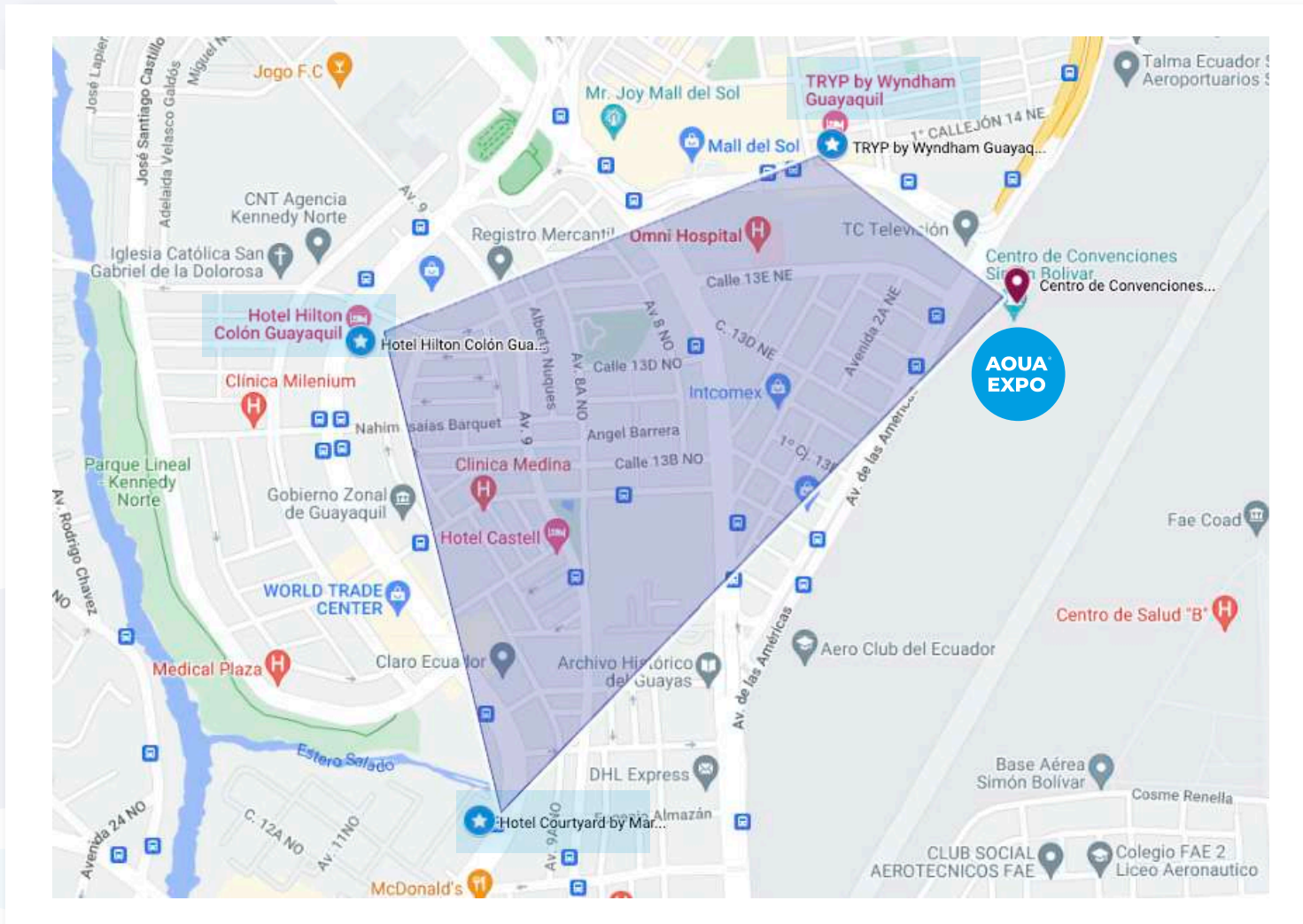

- **ARRIVAL IN GUAYAQUIL**

The José Joaquín de Olmedo International Airport is located to the north of the city, close to hotels and business centers, so the distances you will have to travel in most cases will not exceed 10 km (6 miles).

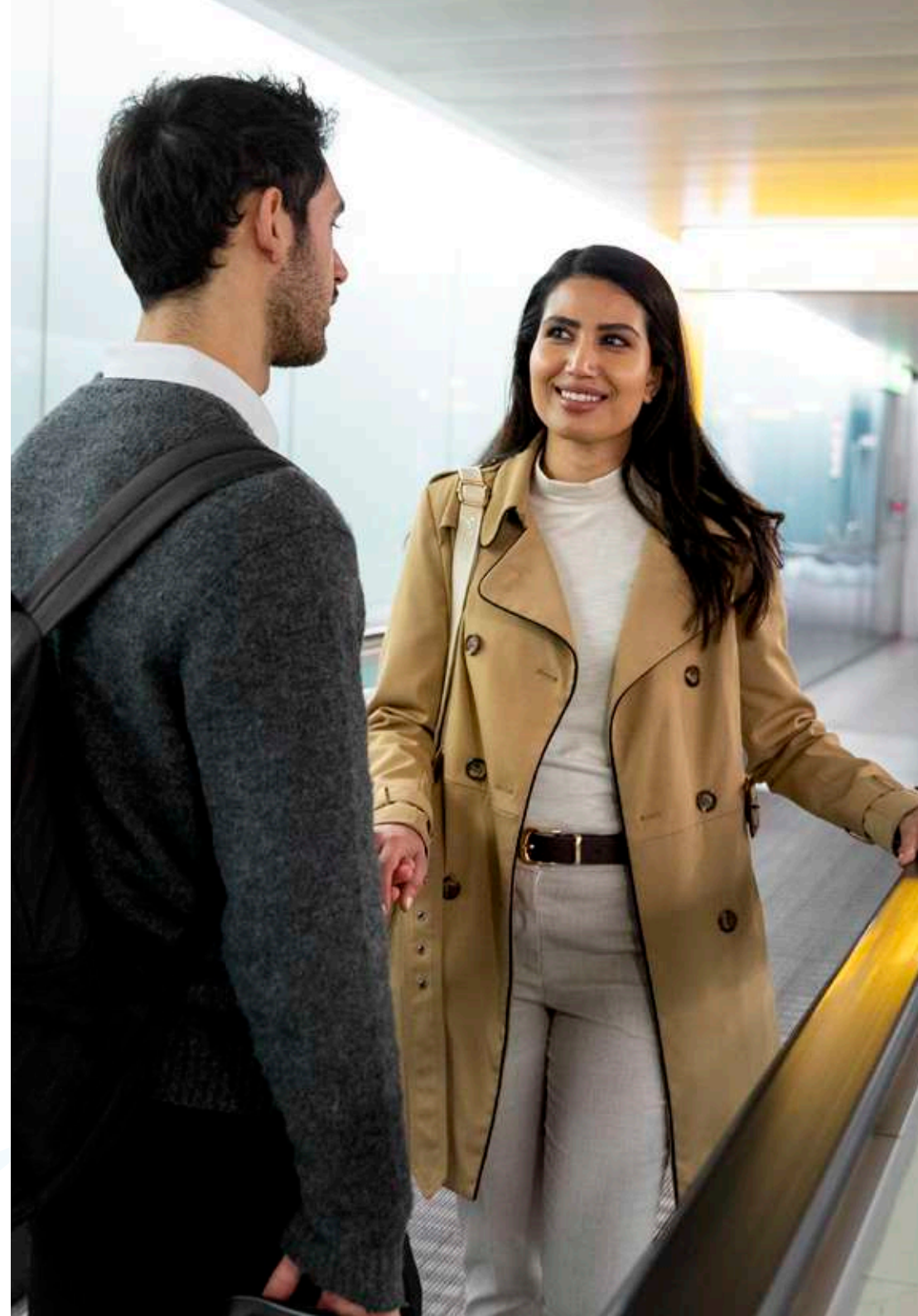
- **TRANSFER FROM AIRPORT TO HOTEL**

Depending on the hotel where you will be staying, the trip from the airport will take no more than 15 minutes and the cost should be around \$10.00 to \$15.00.

- **TRANSFER FROM THE HOTEL TO VENUE**

The AQUAEXPO venue is the Convention Center, located at 406 Las Americas Avenue, 500 meters from the Jose Joaquin de Olmedo Airport, and 5 minutes from the hotel zone, shopping malls and restaurants. The trip from the hotels will take no more than 25 minutes, depending on the time of day and city traffic.

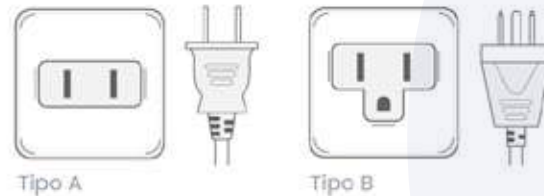

GENERAL TRAVEL AND CULTURAL INFORMATION

Currency type: U.S. dollar - USD.

Electric current: In Ecuador the common voltage is 120 V and the frequency is 60 Hz. The plugs and sockets are type A/B. In the following images you can see the types of plugs and sockets.



Weather: The weather in Guayaquil during the month of October is somewhat hot.

- Daily maximum temperatures hover around 29 °C/84.2 °F and rarely fall below 27 °C/80.6 °F or exceed 31 °C/87.8 °F.
- Daily minimum temperatures hover around 21 °C/69.8 °F, and rarely fall below 20 °C/68 °F or rise above 23 °C/73.4 °F.
